Our Mission: Becoming a family of Christ followers, connecting people with God's Kingdom

Connecting People to God's Kingdom (Part 1) (Matt 13; 11:1-6; 12:22-28)—The Kingdom of God is the most biblical summary description of all of God's work in the world. Like any "kingdom," it presumes the Lord as King, and seeks to bring all of creation under his rule and reign. Unlike many kingdoms, Jesus modeled a pathway that sought to accomplish this goal through peace and love instead of conquest and violence. But the Kingdom extends to all things! God is reconciling to himself people, communities, and all of creation. It started small and has continued to grow for almost two millennia now. Christ followers live as citizens of God's Kingdom, both here and now, and also in the age to come. And they serve under his banner, to bring about the reconciling, saving work of Christ himself.
