current worship series: Christ In You

Help for α Helpless Situation (Rom 5:6-8, 8:35-37; Gal 3:10-25)— For anybody in need of help, especially if they are completely unable to help themselves, the first necessity is for some outside party to be willing to assist. In the biblical world, help was usually offered with an expectation of some reciprocating service. In today's world, some people are paid to offer help to those in need. But in God's case, there is no payment that can be made, nor is there a reciprocating gift that he needs. His intervention into the messy, broken situation of humanity was and is clearly initiated solely by his love for us. The words "love," "grace," and "mercy" are all used by Paul frequently, and all of them speak to the beneficent nature of God that prompts him to enter our broken situation and offer a solution.
