# current worship series: Christ In You

We Need Somebody to Take Our Place (Gal 3:10-14; 2 Cor 5:14-21; Rom 5:6-8)—Paul uses a variety of images to describe the work of Jesus on the cross. One of his most frequent explanations is that of a substitution. Because people are sinful and stand opposed to God, they needed someone who would take their place. So God made him who had no sin to be sin for all of humanity. Not only did Christ take our place, bearing the punishment for our sins, but he also has placed his own righteousness on those who are called his. The substitution model of Christ's work points to the importance of trusting in Jesus because he is the only one capable of taking our place and putting us in his own.
