In Your Capable Hands (Isa 2:6-9, 22; Isa 51:1-8; Ps 119:81-88, 78:1-8)—There are a few people who can cut their own hair, trim the back of their neck, or give themselves a pedicure. Sure, you can do it yourself, but it is easier to trust someone else to help. The same can be said for life in general. We can go through life making our own way and trusting fully in our own strength and abilities, but the people of God in the Old Testament recognized that a life lived with God should bring about TRUSTING God.
