Backstage: Jesus: A Year of Obscurity

A Sign of Things to Come (John 2:1-12)—John's Gospel is primarily aimed at offering "signs" that Jesus was indeed the Son of God. Scattered throughout the book one finds a variety of examples that the apostle found to be convincing evidence to the truth of Jesus's own claims. And the first of those signs transpired at a wedding feast. The nature of the event was incredible, to be sure, but its location and its rather covert nature both speak to the mysterious power that Jesus would display, visible to those with eyes to see, and pointing towards a day of great celebration.
