Shear Shave Shine: Styles for the Soul

Better Than All the Rest (Psalm 13; 6:8-10; 69:32-36; 23)— A regular element of Old Testament prayer, as revealed in the Psalms, was drawing upon God's character and past deeds. This practice illustrated the person's trust and confidence that God was both capable and willing to help, as well as encouraged God to act in ways consistent with how He had acted in the past. In this sense, the Prayer of Confidence is both a praise and a plea. It fits the bill of glorifying God for his many attributes and powerful actions, while requesting that he put those attributes and power to work on our behalf once again.
